**Course Location**

**Reasonable Adjustment**

If a person with a disability meets essential entry requirements, the Training Organisation must make changes or "reasonable adjustments" necessary for that person to perform their course-work.

In most situations, the student with a disability will be able to tell the Training Organisation what he or she needs to be able to study. If necessary, the Training Organisation should also seek advice from disability areas within government departments or organisations that represent or provide services to people with a disability.

Adjustments may include:

- Modifying educational premises. For example, making ramps, modifying toilets and ensuring that classes are in rooms accessible to the person with a disability.
- Modifying or providing equipment. For example, lowering tables
- Changing assessment procedures. For example, allowing for alternative examination methods such as oral exams, or allowing additional time for someone else to write an exam for a person with a disability.
- Changing course delivery. For example, providing study notes or research materials in different formats or providing a sign language interpreter for a deaf person.
